David Hayes Welcomed everyone.

1. Introduction of LL Sponsors

- Dean White, the representative of our sponsor Fielder’s Choice, the official ball suppliers of LLWA. Dean spoke about approved equipment for LL & JL are stocked at the store and have some specials on at the moment. He made mention that they stock team benches which are light weight and easy to store. Please contact Dean with any queries.
- Julie Ninnis from Holidays for you (Jetset) are the sponsor with complete naming rights for our State Championship, National & International programs. Her support is invaluable to the High Performance programs in Little League. Julie spoke about how helping LL is very fulfilling. She helps with the tournaments and looks after bookings and itinerary for the groups. This year Cape Town has been added into the tournament schedule and she will be traveling to Cape Town to see what is available so she can let us know what to expect for those interested in going to the tournament.

2. Junior Girls – Colin Keen sends his apologies for not attend as is not well. We will work on what was sent out to all.

3. Clearances and transfers in the Junior League environment
 - Not much of an issue with JL at the moment
 - Be mindful that when transferring from one club to another, if a mass exit, some kids may not be eligible to play in future championships.
4. Mandatory Email address for every player on the database

The new database has a Mandatory setting for email addresses. If a player has no email address then a club or registrar email address needs to be used. LLWA / BWA send LL information out via email to members, Camps, Clinics etc... and also use for contacting individuals for State team Selections by invitation for LLWA programs.
5. Older age LLI Pathways
 - David has spoken to the ABF and just waiting for a reply regarding National programs.
 - There are four age group pathways in LLI Championships. Little League (U13), Junior League (U15), Senior League (U17) and Big League (U19)
 - Intermediate JL (JL70) is purely a developmental program as has no state championships as there is no World Series Pathway.
 - Junior League / Senior League State championships are played on a 90-foot diamond.
 - Junior League and Senior League State Championships will run in the Second half of January. David Hayes will send out the Tender documents to host this tournament.
 - Proposal Big League Charter team – has provision in rules to merge charters, so it may come down to only having 2 charters. We will keep you updated.
 - Senior League – Two smaller charts can combine to make a team. Currently waiting information from the ABF.
 - Winners of the JL & LL LLSC will be going someway.
