1.0 Sponsor Presentation

2.0 Clearances and Transfers in the Little League environment.

- Little League International (LLI) are happy with the Clearance system we have. Transfers should not be automatic.
- It will be a requirement to send the ABF our Clearance list to be audited. LLI & the ABF will check to see where transfer are happening and reserve the right to restrict players in State Charter teams if players are mass exiting to other charters.

3.0 Mandatory Email address for every player on the database

The new database has a Mandatory setting for email addresses. If a player has no email address then a club or registrar email address needs to be used. LLWA / BWA send LL information out via email to members, Camps, Clinics etc... and also use it when trying to contact members individually.

- 4.0 Selection of Tournament Coaches after our state has sent a team to the World Series USA when choosing coaches they should:
 - have the ability to handle Media requirements. They need to be able to represent Australia properly.
 - LLI Media is a requirement for the Head Coach
 - Their personality should be able to cope with stress
 - Central Firebirds Coach Glen Tovey was a great example of how to handle oneself before the media and all the duties he had to carry out outside of the game of baseball.
 - Make sure when selecting coaches, that they are sufficiently accredited. All Coaches for State Championship teams must be a Lever 3. Machine Pitch team coaches need to be a Level 2. We do not want what happened prior to the last tournament with coaches rushing to get accredited. You have from now till handing in your State Championship Nomination form to have your coaches Accredited.

5.0 Minor League Gala Day Competition

- Kalamunda has put together a proposal to LLWA to run 4 Gala days through the season for Minor Pitch.
- Fees to LLWA apply
- Players need to be registered on the database
- Games Played 6 games played is the requirement for players to enter into the State Championship
- This program can help clubs who do not have the ability to run a full season
- Have had a lot of interest from Teeball clubs and clubs not able to run a full season
